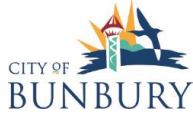

TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Eligible artists are those who have resided in Western Australia for more than one year prior to July 2019.
2. All works submitted must be original work of the artist and must have been created between May 2018 and May 2019 and NOT have been previously exhibited.
3. All entry forms as well as 6 digital images of recent work, a recent CV, artist statement and entry fee must be received by **4pm on Friday 26 October 2018**. No late entries will be accepted.
4. The exhibition will open on Saturday 18 May and run until Sunday 21 July 2019. Work must be available for the duration of the exhibition.
5. Entry fee is \$35 (non-refundable) per artist. Payment is by credit card or cheque (to be made payable to: City of Bunbury, PO Box 21, Bunbury WA 6231).

SELECTION CRITERIA

- A selection panel will consider entry submissions and selected artists will be notified by **Friday 9 November 2018**.
- The selection panel reserve the right to select works for the Bunbury Biennale 2019.
- The selection process will be based on both the quality and variety so that the exhibition reflects both the standard and the broad range of work submitted.
- The City of Bunbury reserves the right to exclude works for the exhibition.

SALES & COMMISSION

- All works selected must be available for sale.
- The sale prices remains fixed for the duration of the exhibition.
- The City of Bunbury offers no guarantee of the sale of artwork.
- Sale price includes a commission of 33% or 44% if you are represented by a gallery. This commission must be included in the sale priced determined by the artist.
- Works acquired through the City of Bunbury Art Collection from the Bunbury Biennale will become the property of the City of Bunbury at the completion of the exhibition on 21 July 2019.

DELIVERY, FREIGHT & INSURANCE

- Artworks must be delivered to the Bunbury Regional Art Galleries between 10am and 4pm on **Wednesday 1 May & Thursday 2 May 2019**.
- A delivery form must be securely attached, but not glued, to each artwork.
- Artists must arrange and meet the cost of freight to and from the Bunbury Regional Art Galleries. No artwork will be accepted where there is freight to pay.
- All entries must be appropriately packed to withstand travel. The City of Bunbury will not accept responsibility for works damaged in transit.
- The City of Bunbury will not insure the works while in transit.
- Artists are responsible for the insurance of their artworks throughout the duration of the exhibition.
- All works must be suitably presented, ready for exhibition. Framing is optional. Artworks must meet health and safety standards when installed or may risk rejection from the exhibition.
- All two dimensional works must be fitted with **D-latches positioned 30mm** from the top of the work.

- Unsold works must be collected on **Monday 22 July and Tuesday 23 July** between 10am and 4pm. The City of Bunbury accepts no responsibility for the safekeeping of works after this date.

COPYRIGHT

- Copyright remains with the artist but the Galleries reserve the right to produce the artwork for publicity and education purposes.
- In accordance with Australia's Moral Rights legislation, the Gallery will publish the Artist's specified copyright credit line as provided by the Artist. This will appear with any reproduction of the artwork.
